Re: Standards of Uniform and Appearance

I am writing to reinforce and remind you of the high standard of uniform and appearance expected from all students at Central Academy. I am concerned that a significant number of students are falling below our standards.

As is clearly stated on the Academy website, trousers and skirts must be charcoal grey and tailored – no skinny jeans, legging type trousers or lycra skirts are permitted, skirts should be knee length.

No jewellery other than a wrist watch is permitted. Makeup must be minimal and natural – as such heavily drawn eyebrows and false eye lashes are not permitted. In addition to these existing rules it has now been decided that acrylic/false nails will no longer be allowed to be worn in the Academy.

Daily monitoring of the above will continue with all students expected to comply without exception.

Please be aware that any student who fails to adhere these clear rules following the Easter holidays will face sanctions. There is now a four week window for the purchase of appropriate trousers or skirt if your daughter's current uniform does not meet the standards outlined. No extensions to the time frame will be granted.
