Year 7 Trip to Manchester United Foundation – Wednesday 28th September, 2022

I am pleased to be able to write to you at this early stage in the new school year, to inform you about an exciting opportunity for our Year 7 students. On Wednesday 28th September, we will take all our Year 7 students to Manchester United Foundation to experience a day at 'Old Trafford'.

Through our partnership with the Manchester United Foundation, we are lucky enough to access this behind the scenes experience for our students. The day will include stadium tours, pitch side talks, career and aspiration workshops, team building and much more.

The theme of the visit is to highlight a 'fresh start' for our students. What can you achieve in the next five years to enable you to become successful? We hope students come away feeling inspired, feeling ambitious and determined for success.

The plan for the day will be as detailed below:

- 8.00 am departure from school – students should arrive by 7.45 am in their full school uniform. They will require small snacks and a drink for the morning and afternoon, however they will all have a packed lunch provided. This will include a selection of sandwiches, crisps, traybakes and juice. This will be provided from our school catering service.
- 10.30 am arrival at Old Trafford
- 10.30 am – 2.00 pm – stadium tours, pitch side talks, workshops, teambuilding activities
- 2 pm departure from Manchester United
- 4.30 pm arrival back at Central Academy – students will be dismissed immediately on their return to Carlisle.

There is no cost involved in this trip, staff accompanying students will include Mr Burgess, their Head of Year; Mrs Best, their Year Team Manager, Mrs Nelson, Manchester United School Partner Foundation Officer and their tutors.
