#### 4. Sixth Form Procedures and Admissions

- Upon enrolment at the sixth form we anticipate the majority of students undertaking three subjects. You may initially undertake four subjects, however once you are confident which three subjects you wish to progress with, the fourth option will be removed. Exams for all A Level specifications will take place in May/June of the appropriate year.
- To begin a two year course, applicants should be under 18 years of age on 1st September in the academic year of admission.
- All students are required to attend a programme of tutorials, enrichment sessions and assemblies. Those students who have not yet gained a grade 4 or above in GCSE English or Maths will be required to attend resit lessons.
- All students are also expected to undertake private study. Tutors and teachers will monitor this. All students are expected to engage in community service either within school or outside.
- All students entering the Sixth Form are to attend an induction period at a date to be confirmed in July. This is to ensure that students are on suitable courses and that their approach to their learning and that of Sixth Form life is appropriate.
- Students will be required to attend school on a specified date after GCSE results to confirm their place and enrol. This is normally in the final week of the summer holiday. By signing on students agree to abide by the RRSF Learning Agreement
- All students must satisfactorily complete the six week probation during September and October before their place is confirmed. During this period regular checks are made on:
  - Attendance, Attitude and Behaviour
  - Academic performance
  - Contribution to Sixth Form life
  - Dress Code
- Parents of students who are not offered places may appeal to the Governors.
- There is no automatic right to continue into year 13. The entry requirement for Year 13 successful completion of all required elements of your courses as well as satisfactory level of attendance. In Year 13 all students are required to study the equivalent of three A Levels.
