As a parent at Central Academy I/we will (agreed to when sending your child to Central Academy):

- Support all policies published on the Central Academy website.
- Ensure that my/our child attends the Academy punctually and with minimum absence, not taking my/our child out of school during term time.
- Ensure that my/our child is properly dressed in full Academy uniform which is worn correctly as per our uniform booklet;
- Provide suitable home-learning environment so that my/our child can complete all homework set to the best of his/her ability and ensure that my/our child's planner is signed weekly;
- Attend Parents' Evenings and meetings about my/our child's progress;
- Advise the Academy of any concerns which might affect my/our child's progress/behaviour;
- Inform the Academy of any change in address, contact numbers or parent/carer circumstance.
- Telephone the Academy on the first day of absence by 9am with a clear explanation of the absence and ensure my/our child completes missed work.
- Support the Academy by enforcing behaviour and conduct as per our Positive Attitudes to Learning Policy including the collection of confiscated items, e.g. mobile phones and electronic devices – see it, hear it, take it;
- Ensure that any books that your child loses or deliberately damages are paid for or replaced.
- I/we will not post any adverse comments on social media platforms about the Academy, its staff or students. If there are concerns about the Academy I/we will contact the Academy directly.
